

Performance Pinball Playfield Jacks™ Insert user guide

Standard black rubber inserts are the general use interface which allows extra protection for your game when using Playfield Jacks™ and supports most games with or without factory and aftermarket side art blades.

These inserts can be removed by pulling downward to separate from the body of the Playfield Jacks.

Optional insert set (purchased separately) can be useful in cases where additional cabinet clearance is needed. As an example, if your game has “Mirror blades” installed, magnetic or other type mounting strips for aftermarket lighting such as “PinLights”, “Pin Stadiums”, etc., or temporary protection such as “Pin Shields” or other cabinet mounted hardware is utilized.

L-shaped inserts - To use the optional inserts first remove the standard U-shaped inserts and replace with the L-shaped insert into the Playfield Jack(s). Ensure to match the top internal angle of both pieces in order to ensure flush insert fitment.

Please note, these L-shaped inserts can be flipped between the Left and Right jacks in order to provide protection on either side of the cabinet depending on your needs.

As an example, you may place the rubber insert(s) so that they interface with the mirror blade or other interior component when mounted, leaving the open side to make contact with the outside area of the side rail.

Alternately you may flip the L-shaped insert over 180° and re-mount into the opposite jack, L/R so that the rubber makes contact with the outside area of the side rail, allowing the open side to make contact with the magnetic strip of an aftermarket lighting system.

Insert pads - To use the optional pad inserts first remove the standard U-shaped inserts and replace with the flat pads so that they sit flush at the top of the jack. Orientation is not required for these inserts.

These pads are useful when neither the U-shaped or L-shaped inserts are able to provide the room required for fitment or if you have a fragile component, you would prefer not to interface with. These pads will provide protection on the top side of the rail specifically while working on your game.
